KIM Clinical Services Program

The Clinical Services Program at KIM is dynamic and community-led, built around the principles of First Nations Sovereignty, First Nations–specific anti-racism, and responsiveness to Indigenous health priorities.

All employees and contractors—including PAs—are expected to demonstrate a strong commitment to these values through culturally safe and collaborative practice.

Compensation & Benefits

- Independent Contractor Rate: \$49.52-\$118.17/hr (6-step scale based on experience)
- Daily Per Diem: \$95/day (in addition to hourly rate)
- Optional Employee Model: Includes pension & health benefits
- Education Reimbursement: BLS, ACLS, PALS, and eligible development programs
- After-hours work billable at the regular rate
- Travel, accommodation, and eligible expenses covered

Work Schedule & Travel

- Full-time equivalent: 2,080 hours/year (includes travel time)
- Typical schedule: Monday to Thursday travel (or Friday), with flexibility
- Extended rotations of 7–14+ days encouraged for out-of-province candidates
- 40+ hour workweek on average, including on-call, clinical work, and travel

- 1st On-call (off-site): Minimum 8 hrs billable/day
- 2nd On-call (off-site): No guaranteed hours

On-Call Stipends

- Weekday 1st: \$200/day | 2nd: \$100/day
- Weekend 1st: \$300/day | 2nd: \$150/day
- Additional hours billable in 15-minute increments after 8 hrs
- PA hourly Independent Contractor Clinical Rate: \$49.52 \$118.17 (6 step scale)
